Course Specific Fees

Tuition Waiver for Arkansas Residents 60 & Over

As provided by Act 678 of the Arkansas Legislature, tuition is waived for Arkansas residents age 60 and over who wish to take credit courses. Eligible students must pay any applicable course/lab fees and purchase textbooks.

Refund of Tuition

Tuition will be refunded on a prorated basis according to the date of official withdrawal and the number of credit hours in which the student is enrolled. Course fees are not refundable unless the student withdraws prior to the first day of class. The Spring 2025 refund schedule is as follows: full-term classes dropped by January 28 receive 80% tuition refund.
